# HTML



Blank Index.html page

1. Open up your Sublime Text Editor, and drag your "My First Website" folder on to the application. You should now have the file structure available on the left of the editor.

2. Go back to your folder and open it. Inside you have three files (if not, please go back to the first tutorial and set up your first website folder!). One of the three files is "index.html", and if you double click on it you will open up your default browser with a blank white website. This is fine!! :)

## W3Schools.com

W3schools is a great site to help us in our journey to learn code. Go to the website and find the "Learn HTML" link. Once on the HTML page you will have access to a whole bunch of documentation!



### GETTING OUR BASIC CODE

Click on the link "HTML Basics" and you should be able to find the first code we need.. Copy and past it into your "index.html" page.

### ADDING LINKS

Before we're done we need to attach our CSS and JavaScript files to our "index.html" so that our designs and functions will work! Take a look at the code below and notice the **difference** with the one above!
